PHOTOGRAPHY 9 Photoshop Workflow

- 1. Open Your Image in Photoshop
- 2. Crop if necessary 9.5 in X 6.333 in / 180 resolution
 - OR resize Image / Image Size largest side = 9.5 inches (other side to 6.333 in) / Resolution = 180



- 3. Duplicate background layer (Ctrl J)
- 4. Image / Adjustments / Levels (Ctrl L) / Red (then Green, then Blue) Drag the black and white triangles to the base of the mountain
- 5. Image / Adjustments / Shadow Highlight (don't overdo it)
- 6. Image / Adjustments / Hue/Saturation (Ctrl U)
 -try individual colours
 -try reducing Saturation to -100 to see image in Black and White

7. Filter / Sharpen / Unsharp Mask (try 100%, 1.5, 3 OR 150%, 0.8, 3)

- Image / Adjustments / Brightness/Contrast
- Layer / Flatten Image (Ctrl E) Framing:
- 10. Make sure you have white as your foreground and black as your background color.



11. Image / Canvas Size / Add 20 pixels of white to both (1730 / 1160). A white border will appear around your image.
