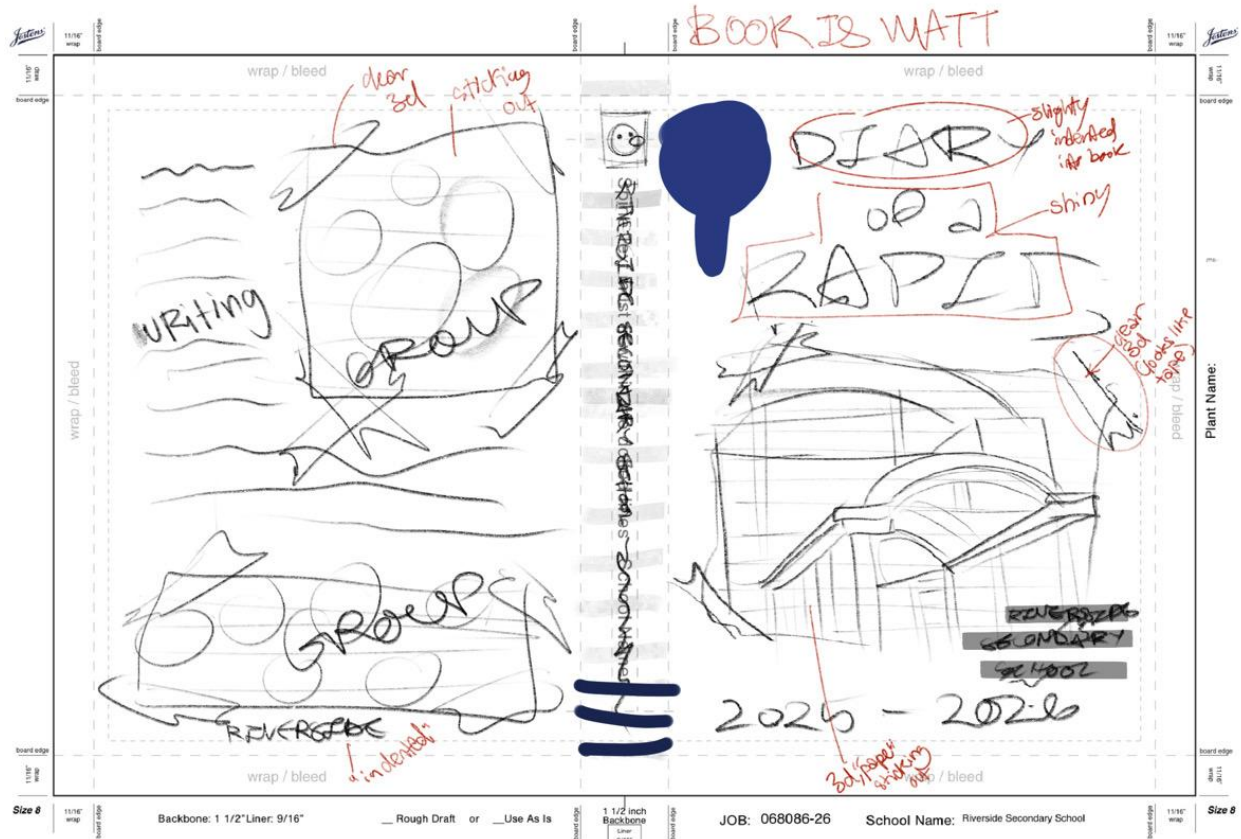
1. “Our bloopers make the best memories.”

Reds – VI Cardinal Red, FS Rebel Red

Yellows – CL Goldenrod, SP Autumn

Greens – TR Green, TR Bright Green

Blues – VI Paradise Blue, RF Peaceful, TR Blue

Purples – VI Regal Purple, IN Electric Purple

Pinks – SM Bubble Gum, SF Pink

- Add colour to the text if you feel it suits the page. (Only assigned colours)

Sub headline

Article Font:

- AYT Avalon (minimum 10)
- Keep black and white

- Ex. "Quotes" – Jordan Oke (12)
- Captions should be quotes, or things that add to the viewers perspective. Avoid stating the obvious.
- Good caption ex. "Rapids make a come back in the final minute after being down 0-1" this information isn't known to the viewer, so it adds onto the visual storytelling.

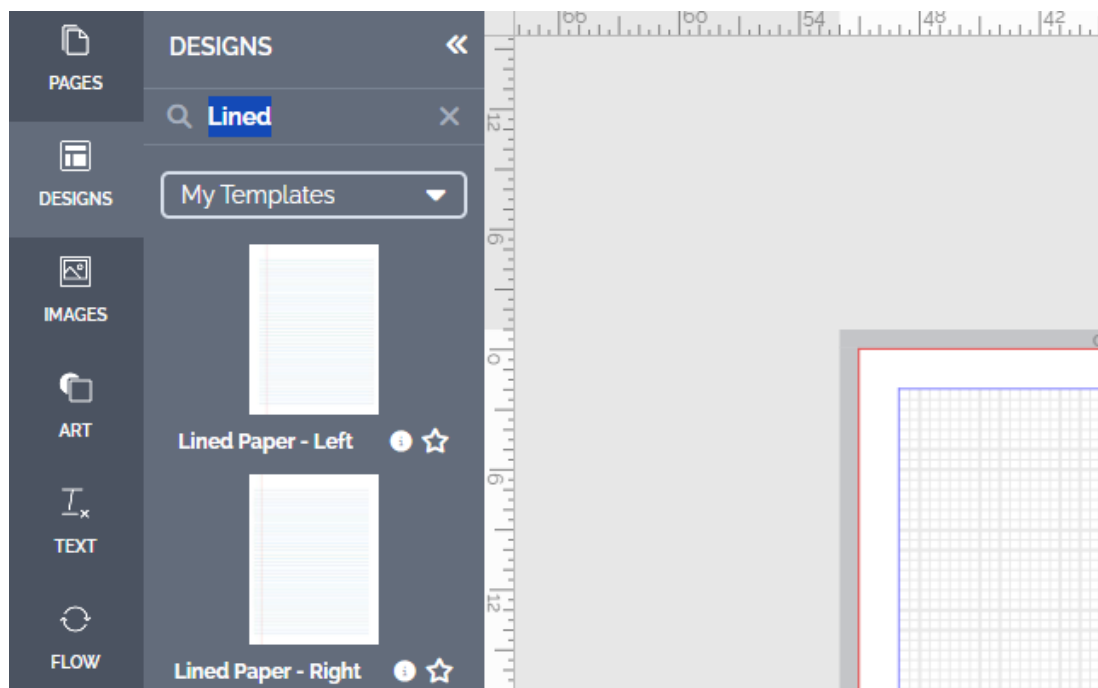
- AYT Avalon (9-12)

Background Options:

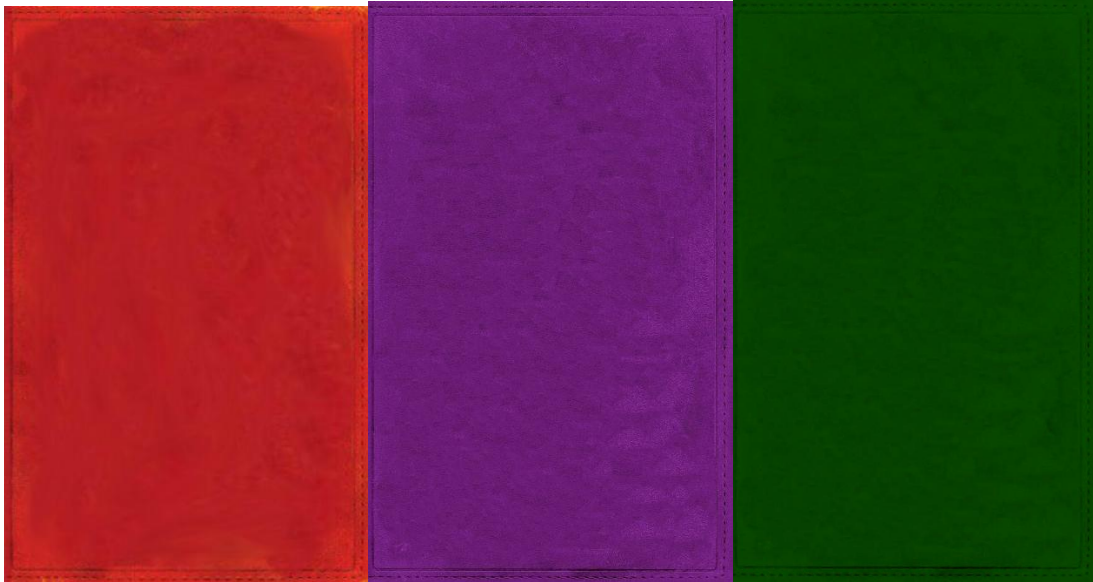
Option 1: Lined Paper

Design Elements (Clip Art):

Line art – search “doodle”

Thumb Tacks – search

Tape – search “Tape”



Line art ideas for Megan:

- Sport equipment (volleyball, basketball, etc.)
- Lockers
- Christmas (presents, ornaments, snowflakes, etc.)
- Halloween (pumpkins, spider webs, bats etc.)
- Cameras
- Grad cap, Diploma Roll
- Poppies
- Microphone (Spoken word)
- Art supplies

Keep in mind when building your pages

- Don't go overboard with decorative elements, prioritize content.
- Ensure snap to grid is on if adjusting frame sizes, shapes, etc. (**View > Grids & Guides > Snap to Grid**)
- Choose from the templates designated to the section (Sports, academics, clubs, etc.)
- Stick to given colours for each section (See assigned sections/colours)
- Don't use different fonts or exceed font limits
- Use correct punctuation and capitalization

Uploading and Shooting Photos:

- Don't upload blurry, severely over/under exposed photos
- Don't upload the back of heads
- Don't upload the same or very similar photos (even if they are good, please choose the best one)
- Take photos at different angles, don't use just landscape
