Conceptual Relevance / Content

The content must be:

1. your picture
2. your full name
3. your schedule of classes

Instructions

ID Card Instructions:

1. Get your picture taken
2. Insert SD Card into Computer
3. Find your photo and choose Copy.
4. Go into your student account/Photo 9/Introduction and paste the image.
5. Open Image With / Adobe Photoshop CS6
6. The photo will open in Photoshop

7. Image / Image Size – Height = 4 inches / Resolution = 180 (constrain proportions should be checked)
8. Use shortcuts to zoom in and out: Ctrl + / Ctrl -
9. Image / Canvas Size – Uncheck the "Relative" box
10. Set the "Anchor" to the left-middle box
11. Choose your Canvas Extension Color = Black, White, Gray, or Other
12. Width = 6.4 inches / Canvas extension colour = foreground (or background)
13. Text tool (T) / Click once to type
14. Add your name / Change font type, colour, and size
15. Layer / Layer Styles / Drop Shadow / Change settings
16. Rectangle tool (two beneath the Text tool) / 10 px / Set colour in options
17. Layer / Layer Styles – Your choice
18. Text tool = Block 1 – Photo 9 (format size/colour/font)
19. Text tool = Mr. Schoenhals (format size/colour/font)
20. Right-click on the Block 1 layer / Duplicate Layer
21. Move that layer down using the Move tool (top right)
22. Change the text
23. Do the same for Blocks 4 and 5
24. File / Save As
25. Filename = Username_ID.jpg
26. Example = SchoenhalsM_ID.jpg
27. File Type = JPG/JPEG if complete. Photoshop if not complete
28. Save to your photo 9 Folder. Upload it to OneDrive.
29. Image Quality = 12
30. Hand In the Assignment to the Photo 9 Portal Hand In box.

Elements and Principles of Design

Usually projects are structured to teach different Elements and Principles of Design. However this is a skill building exercise and this aspect will not be assessed.

Creativity / Originality

Since this is a skill building exercise, no marks will be assessed for this aspect.

Professionalism marked / 10

Professionalism is based on the attention paid to the accurate and careful presentation of the final project.

The card must be

- 4 inches tall X 6.4 inches wide
- 180 dpi
- colour
- the photo must be on the left side
- the photo must take up half of the card
- your information must be on the right side as in the example
