Cartoon Portrait

Goal: Transform pictures of you and/or friends into cartoon caricatures.

Steps:

- Watch YouTube clip - using Photoshop to transform a photo into a [Cartoon Caricature](#).
- Get a partner to take your picture OR use a picture of you that you like
- You might find it easier to work with a picture where you are looking squarely at the camera
- Watch the demonstration
- Now try it with your own photo
- Create 3 different Cartoon Caricatures. Vary the expression, person, and transformation.

Planning:

- Find 3 good examples of Cartoon Caricatures – they don't need to be photos! In a paragraph, describe how a Caricature is different than a portrait photo.

1. Content/Composition - 4 marks

- Focus on getting tighter shots (medium to closeup) with lots of expression!

2. Technical - 4 marks

- Proper camera work evident
- Photoshop: limit the number of colours used. Eg: no more than 3-4 colours used for skin tone.
- Keep the number of black lines used to define boundaries down as well. Consider removing lines that do not define a particular space.

3. Creativity - 4 marks

- Have fun with the expression!
- Choose particular features to embellish, exaggerate or even diminish!

4. Professionalism - 4 marks

- Professionalism is based on the attention paid to the accurate and careful presentation of the final project.
