Movie Party

Instructions: Host a movie party and show one feature animated film that no one in the group has seen before. Try to pick an animation with some sort of significance. I.e: it could be on the top 100 of the American Film Institute, won an Oscar or other award, or perhaps was a blockbuster release. Invite members from the animation class.

After watching the animated film, Animation 12 students should host a discussion (see questions below). Provide evidence for the discussion. Perhaps you video tape your discussion or use an Online thread such as teams. Submit this evidence to your instructor. The discussion should include the following:

1. Why did your group choose this animation for the Animated Feature Film review?
2. Why is this animation significant? For instance, it might be included in the AFI's Top 100, won an Oscar, was a blockbuster release, or took animation in a different direction from what we normally see.
3. What score does Rotten Tomatoes give this animated feature film? Do you agree with this score and why or why not?
4. Now that you have seen the animation, what do you give it? Why?
5. Will this animated feature film be considered a classic? Why or why not?
